MAIN ACTION: EAT

FOR THIS GROUP SCIENCE IS ESSENTIAL TO REDUCE FOOD COST.

LOW RISK GROUP

CONCERN WITH NEW TECNOLOGIES, INGREDIENTS AND PRODUCTS THAT MAY BRING SHORT OR LONG TERM RISK TO CONSUMER HEALTH.

HIGH CONCERN
WITH
SUSTAINABILITY AND
ANIMAL WELLFARE.

LOW COST GROUP

HIGH CONCERN WITH THE AFFORDABILITY OF THE FOOD.

> CONCERN WITH RESTRICTIVE REGULATIONS, DIFFICULTY IN THE APPROVAL OF INNOVATIONS, EXPENSIVE ANIMAL WELLFARE REGULATIONS.






IMPORTANCE OF THE COST REDUCTION IN BROILERS MEAT ON THE PER CAPITA CONSUMPTION IN BRASIL.
